## general points



- due to DAM-LR enormous move towards a stabilized archiving framework at Lund's new Centre for Languages and Literature including 10 departments and the Humanities Laboratory
- new centre covers about 300 staff members
- many staff members are directly contributing to DAM-LR goals
- the archive and its European integration is a strategic goals for Lund with full support of University
- large investments in equipment used to feed the archive
- in 2006 a completely new server + storage system for ~400 k€
- Lund took over the LAT archiving system
- currently transition from old server to new server



## resource points



- increasingly rich archive content
- due to extensive training courses also including scholars from different humanities disciplines great outreach
- SWEDIA – phonetic dialect corpus
- Swedish-Thai child language
- Kammu language docu
- data from many online recordings (eye tracking, ...)
- the archive is starting to become the focal point of data management at Lund university



## Grid points



- all components requested/installed/integrated
  - IMDI web-portal
  - Handle System for URIDs
  - LDAP solution
  - Shibboleth as Grid middleware
  - certificates via Swedish Grid instance
- intensive talks about ethical issues involved in Grid aspects
- DAM-LR has changed the data management landscape in Lund towards a sustainable infrastructure
