

Cutting MPEG I video using MyFlix (PC)

This document describes how to cut MPEG I video using the MyFlix frame accurate MPEG editing program.

Requirements:

- Windows computer (2000, XP)
- MyFlix 3.1.2

Cutting MPEG I video

- Start MyFlix.
- Open an MPEG I file by choosing “File->Load MPEG”.
- Make sure “Frame Accurate” is selected in the “Edit” menu.
- Locate the frame where you want your clip to start using the playback controls and press the “Clip Start” button (or press down arrow).
- Locate the frame where you want your clip to end and press the “Clip End” button (or press up arrow).
- Export your selection by selecting “File->Trim”. Choose an output name and location and press “Save”.
- If you want to cut another clip from the same file, reset your current selection by pressing the “Reset” button (or press period).
