 - 40 participants from 7 countries trained
 - Topics covered
 - DAM-LR architecture
 - Demo of ingesting LRs into the archive (LAMUS)
 - Using IMDI to describe LRs

- June and October
 - DOBES training courses (MPI)
 - Linguists from all over the world
 - Topics covered
 - Metadata creation
 - Archive organisation and integration
- June
 - ELDP training event at SOAS
 - 20 participants
- September
 - ELAR-ELDP training event at SOAS





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Training events in 2006 (contd.)

- Individual training at Lund throughout 2006
 - Researchers in linguistics, ethnology and musicology, cognitive science, psycholinguistics and writing research
 - Focus on IMDI creation and ingestion
 - “Snowball effect” – content contribution domains:
 - Swedish dialects (Phonetics)
 - Kammu language, music and culture (Linguistics, Ethnography, Musicology)
 - Keystroke logging (online writing research)
 - Tactile reading (online reading of Braille and tactile picture)
 - Eyetracking (online visual reading and picture viewing)
 - One Thai and three Swedish longitudinal case study corpora of child language development with video-links





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Training plans for 2007

- Three training events for all 60 members of the pan-European CLARIN initiative (Common Language Resources and Technology Infrastructure)
 - **Not just training, but also paving the way towards persistent pan-European infrastructures in the Humanities**
- Two courses concerning archiving issues
 - Resource ingestion, metadata and access management for linguists and archivists
- One course concerning deep grid science issues
 - For archivists and system experts
- Spring: Lund
- Summer: Prague
- Autumn: Pisa





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Training plans for 2007 (contd.)

- Two DOBES training courses in June and October
- Two training courses in Buenos Aires and Rio de Janeiro about archiving and archive integration issues addressing a large group of South American linguists
- A training course in Tbilisi about archiving and archive integration issues addressing linguists from Georgia
